## **2 Eligibility Criteria for Entrepreneur Immigration Regional Stream**

# Business Experience and Management Skills

1

## **Demonstrable Business Background**

Candidates must showcase relevant experience in business ownership or senior management positions to qualify for the program.

2

## **Managerial Competence Requirement**

A minimum of three years as a business owner or four years as a senior manager is essential for eligibility.

3

## **Role of Active Management**

Applicants must commit to actively managing their proposed business within the community to ensure its success.

4

## **Contribution to Local Economy**

Entrepreneurs are expected to contribute significantly to the economic vitality of the community they engage.



## Financial Requirements for Applicants

### ◆ Minimum Personal Net Worth

Applicants must possess a verified personal net worth of at least CAD 300,000, ensuring financial stability.



### ◆ Investment Commitment

A minimum investment of CAD 100,000 into the proposed business is a prerequisite for application under this stream.





# Language and Community Engagement Requirements

- **Mandatory Language Proficiency**

A minimum Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) level of 4 in English or French is required for registration.

- **Exploratory Visit Prerequisite**

An in-person exploratory visit to the community is mandatory to understand local opportunities and lifestyle.

- **Community Engagement Focus**

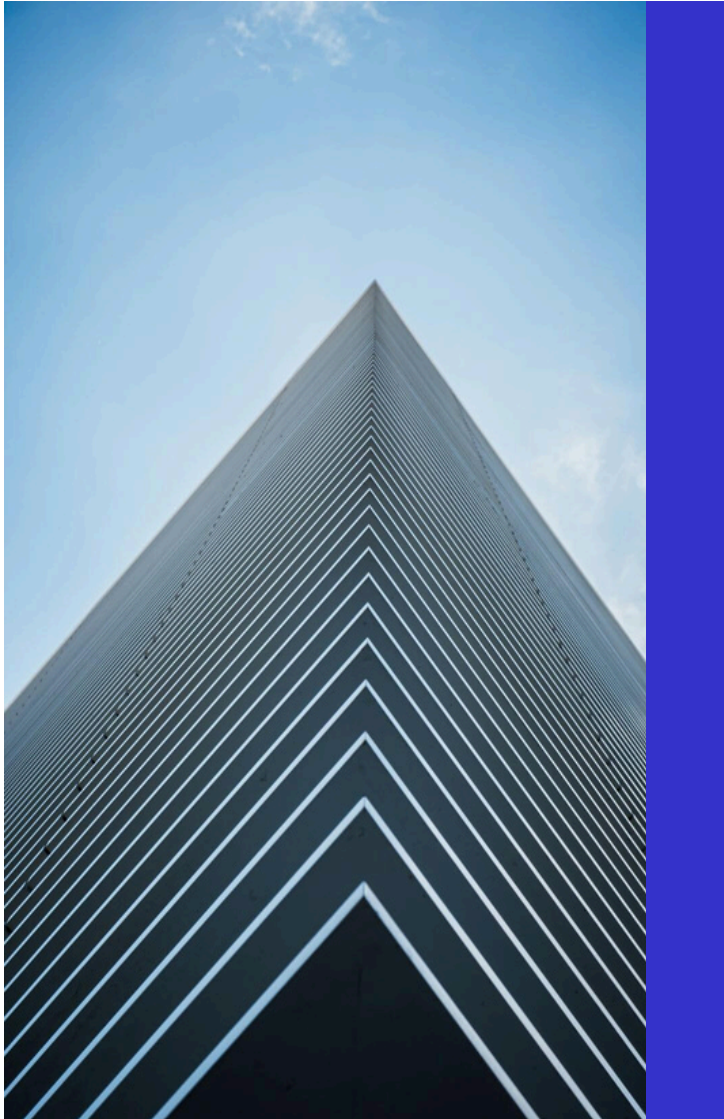
Candidates must engage with community representatives and align their business proposals with local priorities.

- **Referral from Community Required**

A community referral is a critical requirement before submitting a registration under this program.

Entrepreneurs must respect each community's specific procedures, which may involve processing fees and advisory services.

### Infrastructure Assessment

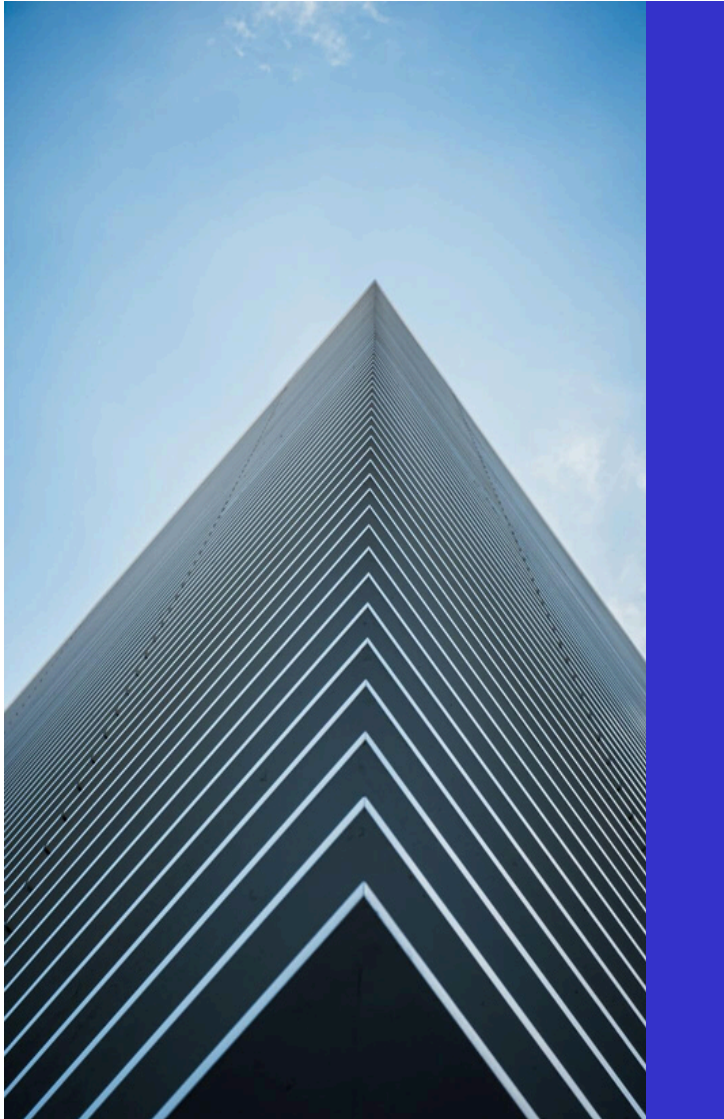
Entrepreneurs evaluate available infrastructure and support systems to facilitate the establishment of their businesses.

## Researching communities and submitting business proposals are crucial initial steps.

### **Understanding Community Needs**

Engaging with local stakeholders to identify economic priorities enhances the relevance of business proposals.

### **Proposal Development**

Creating tailored business proposals that align with community priorities is essential for successful applications.

### **Strategic Community Research**

Conduct thorough research on community profiles to ensure business concepts meet local interests and demands.

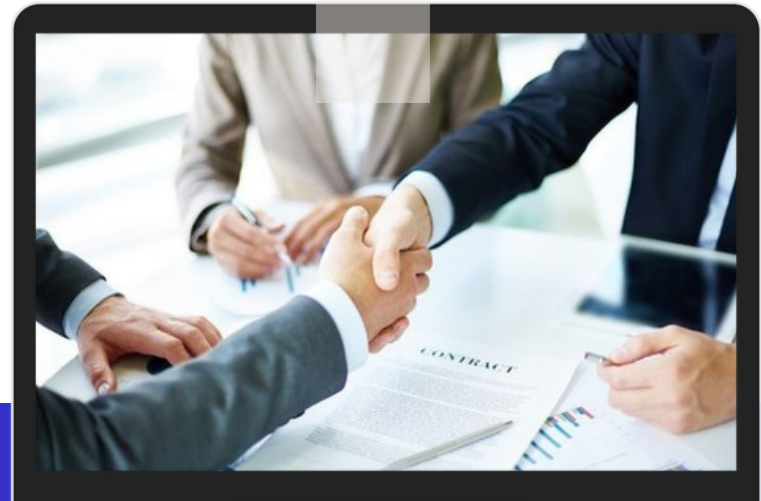
### **Documentation Requirements**
