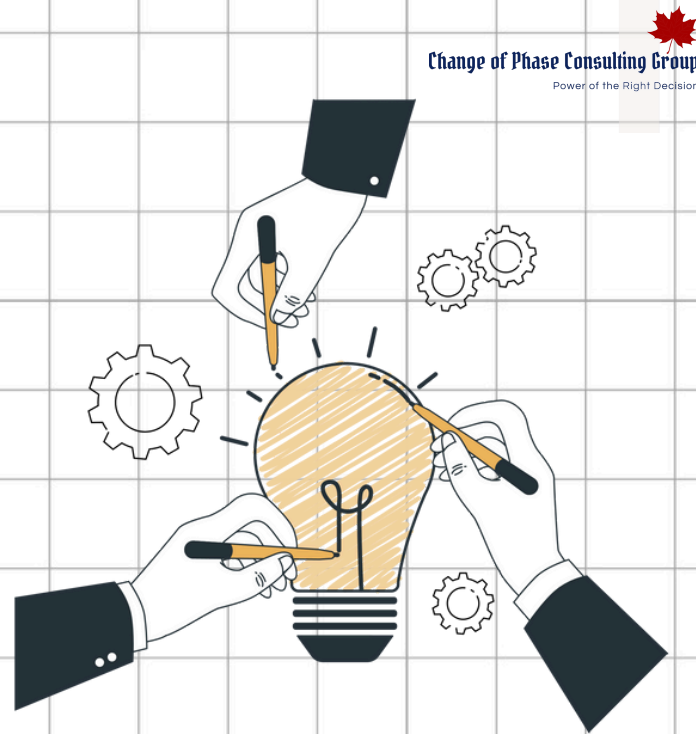

2 Eligibility Criteria for Investment and Language Proficiency





Investment requirements for successful applicants in NTNP



Minimum Investment Amounts

Applicants must invest a minimum of 100,000 CAD outside Yellowknife or 200,000 CAD within the city to qualify for the program.



Personal Net Worth Criteria

Entrepreneurs need to show personal net worth of at least 250,000 CAD outside Yellowknife or 500,000 CAD for applicants in Yellowknife.



Business Ownership Requirement

It is required that applicants maintain at least 33% ownership in their proposed business to ensure active participation.



Commitment to Settlement

A full-time commitment to operating the business and settling in the Northwest Territories is essential for eligibility.





Understanding language proficiency benchmarks for NTNP

● Canadian Language Benchmark Levels

A minimum of CLB level 4 in English or French is mandated for applicants to demonstrate language proficiency.

● Accepted Language Tests

Eligible language tests include IELTS for English, CELPIP for English, and TEF for French, ensuring standardized evaluation.

● Validity of Language Tests

Language test results must be valid and submitted within the last two years to ensure current proficiency levels.

● Importance of Language Skills

Proficiency in one of Canada's official languages is crucial for effective communication and integration into the business community.
